• Acceptance of papers:

Authors will be notified of acceptance of their paper and the method of presentation (oral or poster) by 1st August 2005.

• Oral presentations:

The time limit for oral contributions will be exactly 20 minutes including discussion time. Authors can make use of video projection.

• Posters:

Posters will be presented during special sessions. The panels for the poster presentation are of the following size: height 240 cm, width 97 cm.

• Proceedings:

Each participant attending the International Meeting will receive a copy of the proceedings free of charge.
